Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

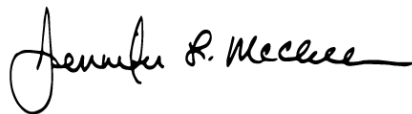
I am requesting funding for the Lawrenceville Wastewater Treatment Facility Expansion project in fiscal year 2025.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Lawrenceville, located at 400 North Main Street, Lawrenceville, VA, 23868. The funding would be used to make major upgrades and expand from 1.2 million gallons per day (MGD) to 2.2 MGD of the Lawrenceville wastewater treatment capacity.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will upgrade an existing wastewater treatment facility to improve functionality and capacity to provide public access to a reliable wastewater treatment facility. This project will improve the wastewater discharge quality being discharged into the Virginia Scenic Meherrin River, as it negatives through the Chowan River Basin. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
