Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for the Prince George County for Beechwood Manor Asbestos Pipe Replacement project in fiscal year 2025.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Prince George County, located at 6602 Courts Drive, Prince George, VA 23875. The funding would be used to provide water system rehabilitation and reliability improvements for a municipally owned and operated community water system. The project will replace approximately 21,000 linear feet of 4" and 6" asbestos cement water lines originally installed around 1975.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it replaces aging waterlines that are contributing to diminished water quality and marginal pressures currently experienced by the customers served by these waterlines. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
