Accessible Campus Commuting and Expanded Student Savings





- The Accessible Campus Commuting and Expanded Student Savings Act would help American families using 529 plans to apply their savings toward a broader range of educationrelated expenses, ultimately making college and apprenticeship programs more accessible and affordable.
- Though transportation is a significant nontuition barrier for many students, the **cost of transportation is often overlooked** as students weigh the affordability of higher education.
- High transportation costs could hurt student retention and success at a time when institutions are already seeing declining enrollments post-COVID.

- Although this bill is just one piece of the puzzle to alleviate student pressure, we believe it is a necessary one that addresses real concerns felt by students and their families.
- Specifically, the Accessible College Campus and Expanded Student Savings (ACCESS) Act extends eligible educational expenses covered by the 529 Program to include student parking and transportation costs at colleges, universities, and apprenticeship programs.
