Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for the City of Richmond Combined Sewer Overflow Waste Water Treatment Pumping Station in fiscal year 2024.

The entity to receive funding for this project is located at 900 E Broad St Richmond, VA 23219. The funding would be used for major upgrades to the Wastewater Treatment Plant Main Pumping Station to reliably pump 140 million gallons daily to reduce combined sewer overflow.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project will reduce bacteria, providing improved water quality in the James River for Richmond and downstream communities, and enhance the overall river ecosystem.
